	Teams are needed to do a variety of ministries. Food and clothing ministry involves sorting and working directly with the families receiving services. Kids Club is a Backyard Bible Club at the local government housing authority. Home repairs are provided to low income families living in substandard conditions. Each volunteer is asked to pay \$325 per person, which covers housing Sunday night through Friday morning, meals Monday morning through Thursday evening, building materials, construction project staff on site, and a t-shirt. Team leaders are asked to have basic construction skills for those projects. Also required is a sensitivity to the needs of the families struggling in poverty. Teams are asked to lead the evening worship time. If a team would prefer staying in a hotel instead of a dorm room, the fee would be reduced by \$45 per person. Ideal team size is 15 members. However, we can adjust up or down. If the team exceeds 30 members we will split it up for two projects. Ministry is seeking up to 4 teams per week for the 8-week summer. Outside of summer only 1 team per week. We ask that there be enough chaperones for housing. An example would be if there were 10 male youth and 10 female youth there would need to be at least 2 adult male and 2 adult female chaperones per housing requirement. Adults are not allowed to room with a youth unless they are a parent or a legal guardian. <b>Note:</b> Teams working with children and youth will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all members over the age of 18.
