#### **Children's Ministry/Community Canvass/Church Revitalization**

Anchorage, Alaska

Teams are needed to help congregation reach out to their surrounding community. Team will go house to house with door hangers as part of getting the word out as to the renewal of the church to the surrounding community – and as invitation for children to attend a Wednesday night children's ministry, which the team will lead in. The pastor has mapped out the community for such activity. Team may also engage people (church information/prayer walking/ praying for people) on a coastal walkway that is very popular with residents and visitors. It is within walking distance of the church. Team will be lodged at mission house in Wasilla. Cost for lodging and all in-state transportation for the week is \$500 per person. Team will be responsible for their own food and meal prep. Mission house has kitchen that team can use. Team can also use church kitchen for lunch prep during the day. Team will have Thursday as an "Alaska Adventure Day" and Friday as a "Discover Anchorage" day prior to flying out. **Note:** Team members working with children will be responsible for conducting professional background checks on all team members over the age of 18. Team leaders will be sent information from Baptists on Mission (BOM) concerning options for this.
