To provide compassionate dental care and referrals to those in need including the poor, uninsured, migrant populations and homeless; ultimately offering not only a physical solution, but a spiritual one as well. We believe that all Christians are called, gifted and sent. Our desire is to help churches involve their members (men, women and students) in missions and ministry in Jesus' name.

### Sponsoring Organizations Will Need To:

1. Contact N.C. Baptists on Mission to choose a date for the clinic. A deposit of \$200 per day is required to secure the date. This deposit is applied to the total cost of the clinic.
2. Enlist volunteer staff (dentists, dental assistants, dental Hygienists, registered nurses, interpreters, counselors and general helpers) to work at the clinic.
3. Identify a target patient group and how to reach them.
4. Provide an evangelical witness. Consider providing food or snacks, hygiene kits, etc.

### Fees\* charged to the sponsoring organization by N.C. Baptists on Mission include:

- \$65/mile round trip from Cary.
- \$8/patient per service to help offset the cost of materials.
- \$3/hour for generator (if needed).
- Meals and lodging (if more than one hour from Cary) for the driver.
