The health screening ministry employs one full time coordinator through Baptists on Mission. In addition, volunteer hosts/drivers transport the mobile unit to and from each site and assist during clinics. Contact Baptists on Mission for information about volunteer opportunities.

**Love God. Love others.**


Matthew 22:37-39

**Our mission:** To provide compassionate health screenings and referrals to those in need.




Sponsoring organizations will need to:

1. Contact Baptists on Mission to schedule a clinic.
2. Enlist volunteer health care providers (registered nurses, physicians, etc.) and other volunteers to staff the clinic.
3. Develop a local network of free, low-cost or sliding-scale providers to ensure appropriate follow-up care for patients.

**Fees charged to the sponsoring organization:**

- \$200 deposit/day to hold the reservation. This deposit is applied to the total clinic cost.
- \$0.65/mile (roundtrip from Cary)
- \$8/patient to help offset cost of supplies
- \$3/hour for generator usage (if shore power is not available)
- Actual cost of the driver's meals and overnight accommodations (if location is more than one hour from Cary)

**Screening tests offered on the mobile unit **may** include:**

- Hemoglobin A1C
- Total Cholesterol and HDL
- Body mass index calculation
- Depression screening
- Vital signs assessment
- Heart disease risk factor assessment
- Basic eye exams (equipment supplied on unit if eye doctor is available).
